Requirements for Educator Nominations

- A Nomination Form including: teacher name, school and district, grade level taught, number of years teaching and photographs of nominee
- Letter of recommendation from FEA Club (One Page)
- A one to two page narrative, prepared by the students, describing:
 1. How the nominee's experience in the classroom has shaped his/her teaching philosophy
 2. What personal passion the nominee brings to teaching
 3. What innovative and creative teaching pursuits the nominee has undertaken
 4. Why nominee enjoys teaching; why they chose the education profession
